I'm just starting to make sales with my short stories, and I'm looking for an agent for an SF novel, hoping to go the traditional publishing route, but I've also written a 100k word YA fantasy with my 10-year-old daughter, and for several hundred dollars we can make sure it shows up at Amazon and Barnes & Noble. 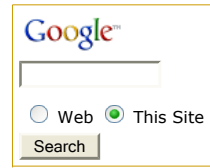
